# Catholic Charities

## Marian House Service Guide

1. **Housing** – *If you are homeless*, we encourage you to complete the ViSPDAT housing assessment, which puts you on a list to access other agencies that may have housing assistance. It expires every three months, so you want to complete a new one every quarter. Please note, this is not the waiting list for Section 8. To find out information on Section 8, contact the Colorado Springs Housing Authority. To make an appointment to complete the ViSPDAT, call 719-866-6284.
2. **Rent Help** – To apply for rent assistance - *if you currently have housing* – visit our website at <https://www.CCharitiesCC.org/rent>. The application is open from midnight on the first of the month through 11:59 p.m. on the fifth of the month. There will be a link in the middle of the page to apply. 3. **Medical** – The SET clinic is available at the Marian House Monday – Friday from 10:30 a.m. – 1 p.m. on a walk-in basis. A provider (doctor, nurse practitioner, etc.) is usually available to help treat minor infections, colds, skin conditions, asthma, etc. They can also help you navigate the health care system.
4. **Mental Health** – A representative from Diversus Mental Health is at the Marian House every Tuesday between 10:30 a.m. – 1 p.m. on a walk-in basis. They can answer questions about the mental health system and connect you with a therapist for counseling, or with a psychiatrist for prescribing meds.
5. **Utilities** – **If you are an individual** needing utility assistance, call Catholic Charities Client Services at 719-866-6284. **If you have children under the age of 18 in the household**, call Catholic Charities Family Connections program at 719-578-1222. They are located at 917 East Moreno Avenue. For more information on Catholic Charities utility help, visit our website at <https://www.CCharitiesCC.org/utilities>. There are also other agencies who provide utility assistance: Crossfire Ministries 719-447-1806, Mercy's Gate 719-277-7470, Salvation Army 719-635-1287.
6. **Employment Assistance** – We offer resume and interview skills assistance as well as referrals to jobs. Please RSVP to a workshop by calling 719-866-6285 or email [jobs@CCharitiesCC.org](mailto:jobs@CCharitiesCC.org). To learn more, visit our website at <https://www.CCharitiesCC.org/HEC>.
7. **Hot Daily Meal** – The Marian House serves a hot meal every day from 10:30 a.m.-1 p.m. You **MUST** be here by 12:45 p.m. to get into the last seating of the day.
8. **Food Pantry** – The Marketplace is our food pantry where people can shop – at no cost – for groceries. To be eligible for the Marketplace, you must be housed (this includes sober-living, apartments, houses), have a refrigerator, transportation (this includes a car, Uber/Lyft, or cab, no bus), and you must meet the income

requirements. To find out if you qualify and/or schedule an appointment, call 719-866-6288 or email [Pantry@CCharitiesCC.org](mailto:Pantry@CCharitiesCC.org). Shopping is by appointment only.

9. **Hygiene Items/Clothing** – The Marian House no longer offers these items. If emergency clothing is needed, try Springs Rescue Mission between 1-3 p.m. on Fridays for families, or Mondays between 1 – 3 p.m. for individuals. West Side Cares may also have these resources: Mon – Thurs, 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
10. **ID/Birth Certificate** – ID and Birth Certificates are provided to individuals involved in Catholic Charities programs. To sign up for programming, you must make an appointment with a case manager to determine eligibility. **To make an appointment with a case manager, call 719-866-6284.** The Springs Rescue Mission also provides this service for those enrolled in their HOPE program.
